UL STUDENTS FORM ADVISORY BOARD TO ADVOCATE FOR VOTER REGISTRATION

As November 3 approaches, a group UL-Lafayette students are calling on their peers to make sure they're represented in this year's presidential election.

LAFAYETTE, LA – An advisory board has been formed by five students in UL's Department of Communication. These students in collaboration with the university's student chapter of the Rotaract Club hope through their proactiveness, their peers will register to vote and exercise their power in this year's presidential election. How will these students get turn-out? They're offering an incentive for students to register.

The coalition formed in July 2020, under the leadership of UL Lafayette Instructor Mrs.

It's the hope of the advisory board that students will no longer stay silent with their opinions.

"A lot of people say, 'My vote doesn't count'..." said Myer in Be the Change – UL's campaign video. These are the comments these five students are tired of hearing, so they're bringing a new way of rallying voters to UL's campus.

Currently, students are being advised to visit "RocktheVote.org" and register through quick and easy registration process. Once students register, they can direct message their confirmation to any of the Be the Change – UL's social accounts to be entered in a raffle for a \$25 gift card. The winner of the raffle will be chosen September 15 at noon. The drawing will be streamed via Instagram and Twitter.

"Rock the Vote" is a nonpartisan nonprofit dedicated to building the political power of young people. The advisory board is not affiliated with any political parties; moreover, they would just like all of their peers to be registered to vote.
